Last Day Event Chart (Explanation)

Eccl. 1:7-9 says, “All the rivers run into the sea; yet the sea is not full; unto the place from whence the rivers come, thither they return again. All things are full of labour; man cannot utter it: the eye is not satisfied with seeing, nor the ear filled with hearing. The thing that hath been, it is that which shall be; and that which is done is that which shall be done: and there is no new thing under the sun.”

Last Day Event Chart (Explanation)

3 SM 338 tells us, “Never are we absent from the mind of God. God is our joy and our salvation. Each of the ancient prophets spoke less for their own time than for ours, so that their prophesying is in force for us. ‘Now all these things happened unto them for ensamples: and they are written for our admonition, upon whom the ends of the world are come:’ (1 Cor. 10:11). ‘Not unto themselves, but unto us they did minister the things, which are now reported unto you by them that have preached the gospel unto you with the Holy Ghost sent down from heaven; which things the angels desire to look into.’” (1 Pet. 1:12).

Last Day Event Chart (Explanation)

This chart was developed on the principle that history repeats itself. “In the Revelation all the books of the Bible meet and end.” (**AA 585**). The stories and many prophecies have more meaning for us today than when they actually occurred.

Our chart is based on and developed with this principle in mind. In fact, we read in the Spirit of Prophecy that the whole life of Christ will be re-enacted in the last days, His ministry, His betrayal, and His crucifixion. In other words, every facet of Christ’s life will be re-enacted in the lives of His people. (**7A BC 226**).

If Christ’s life is to be re-enacted, it would stand to reason that the 70th week of the 490 year prophecy of **Dan. 9** will be repeated as well. The prophecy of **Dan. 9:24-27** foretold exactly when the Messiah the Prince (Christ) would come to the Jewish nation and confirm the (New) ⁴ Covenant with many for one week, ...

Last Day Event Chart (Explanation)

“...and in the midst of the week, He shall cause sacrifice and oblation to cease,...” So the chart depicts that prophecy finding its counterpart in the last days, just as **Matt. 24** is a two-fold prophecy. Just as Christ came to confirm the New Covenant with many in His day, God’s remnant will confirm the New Covenant with many in ours.

Question: At the beginning of Christ’s ministry He told His disciples to start where?

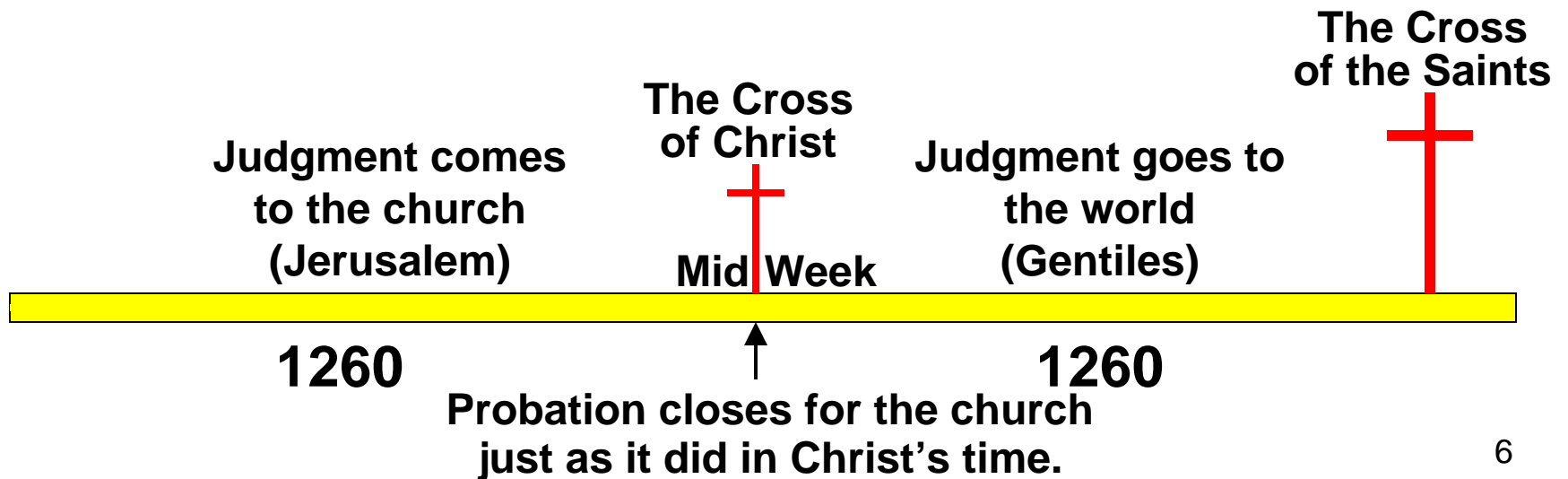
Answer: **Matt. 10:6** says, “But go rather to the lost sheep of the house of Israel.”

Eze. 9 tells us that judgment starts first at the house of God.

Last Day Event Chart (Explanation)

This judgment is represented during the first half of our week, then judgment will go to the world during the second half, thus the 70th week.

So basically, the chart is representative of two weeks, the one during Christ's ministry and the other during our time. The two are superimposed upon each other.

We would like the reader to know, foremost, that this chart is all about **character development alone** and does not address the issue of time specifics.
